## **activate plus**

### Septic Tank Maintenance Usage Chart

---

Sludge and solids can build up in septic systems, causing offensive odors, clogged pipes and system back-up. Adding large amounts of laundry detergents, bleach, grease and other household waste can cause septic system shock.

**activate plus** is an excellent choice for septic tank recovery and maintenance. Its ultra concentrated formula<sup>1</sup>, combined with non-pathogenic bacterial sources<sup>2</sup> results in a safe, effective means of septic tank control.

**activate plus** accelerates the natural decomposition of waste. Once introduced into your system, billions of bacteria produce enzymes which degrade complex organic wastes. This reduces the level of solid waste as well as its odor. The continuous microbial activity assures long-lasting effectiveness and reduces the need for pumping.

#### **Directions For Use:**

##### **Initial Treatment/Shock Treatment Recovery**

Shake **activate plus** well before using. Add one gallon initially for 1,000 gallon tank capacity. Positive results should take place within 10-14 days. When problems have been reduced, continue with the regular maintenance dosage as recommended.

##### **Maintenance**

Shake well before use. Add one quart per month for each 1,000 gallon tank capacity, or one quart per month for every five people using the septic system.
